UK: River Tyne/N Shields, River Tay, Aberdeen, Peterhead, Kinlochbervie, Loch Sunart, Tobermory, Rathlin Island.

Ireland, Republic of: Wexford, Kilmore Quay, Waterford, Fenit Hbr, Kilrush.

West Denmark: Most harbours.

Germany: Nord-Ostsee Kanal, East Frisian Islands.

Netherlands: Delfzijl, Lauwersoog, Den Helder, Harlingen, Rotterdam and Terneuzen.

France: St Valéry-en-Caux, Paris, Port-en-Bessin, River Rance, Port Blanc, Trébeurden, Primel-Trégastel, Loctudy, Iles de Glénan, Port-Tudy, Port Haliguen, St Gilles-Croix-de-Vie, Les Sables d'Olonne, Royan, Port-Médoc, Arcachon, Capbreton, Anglet/Bayonne and St Jean de Luz.

N/NW Spain: Most hbrs, *except* Bilbao, Santander, Gijon, La Coruña, Rias de Ares, Betanzos and Camariñas.

Portugal: The Azores.

SW Spain: Mazagon, Chipiona, Sevilla, Cadiz, Sancti Petri, Barbate, Tarifa, Algeciras, Tangier and Ceuta.
